HIV/AIDS Statistics

- 42 million people are living with HIV/AIDS around the world: 28.1 million live in Africa; 2.4 million of them are children.
- AIDS is the leading cause of death in Africa and the fourth leading cause of death worldwide.
- AIDS orphaned over 12 million children in Africa alone as of 2000, 40 million orphans projected by 2010.

- Of the 6 million poor afflicted with HIV/AIDS, only 400,000 — less than 8% — are receiving anti-retroviral therapy.
- 1,600 children are born with HIV each day; 1,500 of them in sub-Saharan Africa; 1 child dies of AIDS every minute.
- More than two out of three newly infected 15- to 24-year-olds are female.
- With 27 million people living with HIV/AIDS, only two percent in sub-Saharan Africa receive anti-retroviral treatment.

HIV/AIDS now directly afflicts some 42 million men, women and children around the world. An estimated 3 million AIDS victims died in 2003 and 5 million more acquired the virus. UNICEF estimates that more than half of new infections strike people under the age of 25. Girls are more likely than boys to be affected.

The vast majority of people with HIV/AIDS — more than 29 million — live in sub-Saharan Africa, where 8.8 percent of the adult population now carries the virus. Six thousand AIDS victims die each day in Africa alone.

In addition to these government efforts, ELO INC board members and collaborating charity organizations, work to help victims of the disease and to protect people with a high risk of exposure. These campaigns are proving successful at communicating the dangers of HIV/AIDS, and also providing needed medical aid.
